
Your Cheviot pension... online

The Cheviot Trust has invested in a new portal to provide you with 24/7 access to your Cheviot pension information.

The Cheviot Dashboard is a secure website which allows you to view your account details and investments.

- See your current fund value
- View, download or print your latest benefit statement
- View and update your contact details
- Change your marital status and spouse's details
- Update your nominated beneficiaries
- See your projected fund value at retirement
- Review your investments

To use it, you'll need to register using our secure two-factor authentication process. The steps are set out on the next three pages, but if you have any problems you can always get in touch with us on 01702 354 024.



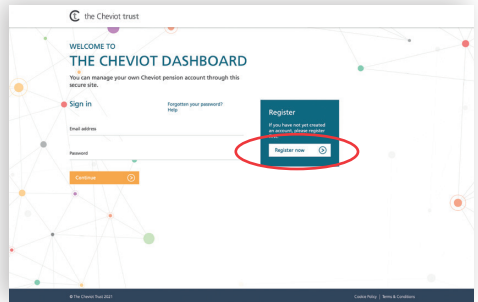

On your first visit

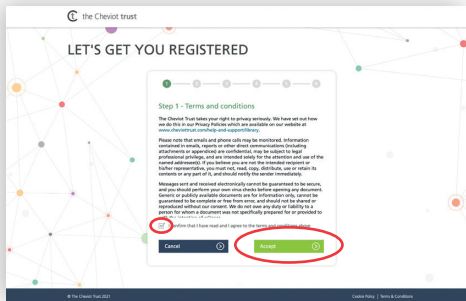
When you visit the Cheviot Dashboard for the first time, you'll need to register. Here's how:

Go to **www.mycheviotpension.com** and click on the 'LOG IN' button at the top of the homepage. Then click on the 'Register now' button.



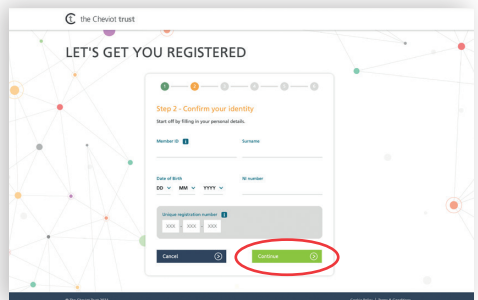
Step 1

Tick the box to accept the T&Cs and click on 'Accept' to continue.



Step 2

Type in your Surname, Member ID, Date of Birth and National Insurance (NI) number. Your Member ID is printed on the top right-hand corner of the covering letter you received with this leaflet, or you can find it on any other correspondence sent to you by the Cheviot Trust. Now enter your nine-digit unique registration number (you will receive this in a separate communication). Click on the green 'Continue' button.



Step 3

Check your details and, if they are correct, click on the green button to continue.

Step 4

Type in your email address and choose a secure password.

It's best to use your personal email address – then, if you change jobs, you can still keep track of your Cheviot pension.

Step 5

Set up two-factor authentication by providing your mobile phone number and click on the green 'Get code' button. In future, whenever you want to access the site (or make changes to your details), we'll send a six-digit code to your phone, to help protect your pension. You can also choose to send the code to the email address you entered in the previous step. This code will be valid for 10 minutes.

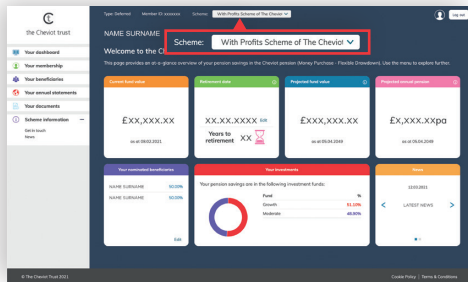

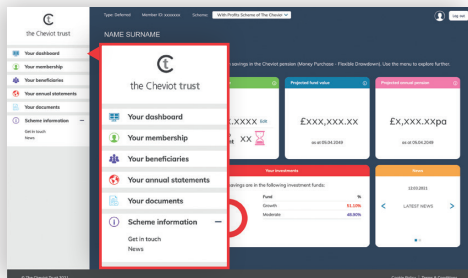
The Cheviot Dashboard – useful tips

The Cheviot Dashboard provides an overview of your Cheviot Pension benefits in the Cheviot Trust.

If you're a member of more than one scheme, you can switch from one scheme to the other using the dropdown menu at the top of the screen.



The menu on the left-hand side of the Dashboard is where you can view your membership details, beneficiaries and benefit statements. You can update your details (including your target retirement age) either by clicking on the 'edit' links on the main Dashboard or via the links on the left.



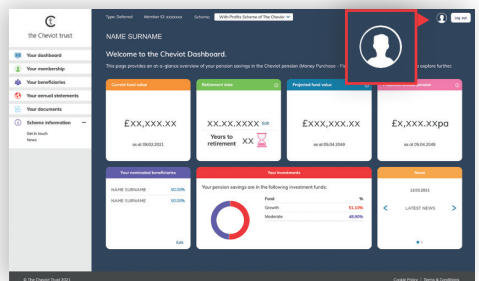
By clicking on the icon next to the Log out button, you can update your personal details and security settings:

Use the 'Forgotten password' link to request a re-set email. Remember to use the email address you registered with, so that the system can find you.

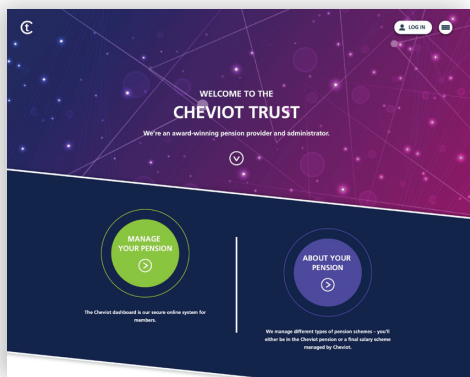
The member website
